## PROSECCO

**NV Villa Sandi Il Fresco Doc**, Veneto, Italy 200ml Bottle .....12.5

Pear drop and floral notes. Fresh on the palate, with a lemony bite and cool apple fruit.

**NV Viticoltori Ponte Prosecco**, Ponte di Piave, Italy .....11/40

Floral notes with suggestions of apricot, lemon and mineral. Fresh and fruity finish.

**NV Nino Franco Rustico Prosecco**, Valdobbiadene, Italy .....65

Fruity and flowery, notes of white nectarine, williams pear and white flowers, soft and delicately textured in the mouth. Awarded 2018 Best in Class - Gold Medal worlds best prosecco.

## BRUT

**NV De Perriere Blanc De Blanc**, Burgundy, France .....9.5/34

Pale gold robe, small bubbles, predominantly fruity with a touch of hazelnut and moss

**NV Howard Park Jeté Brut Blanc**, Margaret River, WA .....48

Filled with Red berry, citrus, baked apple and brioche characters

**2013 Leeuwin Estate Sparkling Brut**, Margaret River, WA .....55

Primary, bright and delicate, the nose features lemon, apple and grapefruit. Beneath lie layers of nougat, brioche, toasted cashews and elevated jasmine. The palate is tight with subtle texture and a fine bead. Lemon and grapefruit are the leading fruits, offset with almond meal through the mid palate and crisp, fine acid structure.

## CHAMPAGNE

**Veuve and Cliquot Yellow Label**, Reims, France .....145

Crisp and full bodied, this stunning sparkler offers notes of bread dough, vanilla, apple, peach, quince and pecan.

**NV Lanson Pere et Fils Brut Champagne**, Reims, France .....138

Magnificent bright golden colour, animated by tiny bubbles. The nose reveals aromas of ripe fruit, honey and spices. On the palette the blend offers a complex, full and persistent impact with honeydew flavours.

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**2006 Moët and Chandon, Epernay, France .....160**

Round, elegant and light. Toasty palate with pear yeast brioche overtones.  
Some fruity notes on aftertaste.

**Lanson Extra Age Pere et Fils Brut Champagne, Reims, France ..... 188**

Vibrant straw yellow with fine bubbles. The first notes of yellow fruit and dried fruit combine quickly with fragrances of honey, biscuit and sweet spices, developing a powerful and aromatic palette.

## **SPARKLING ROSÉ**

**NV Delamere Sparkling Rose, TAS.....58**

Showing true mature Sparkling Rose characters, it has a pale salmon colour and an aroma of fresh strawberry and musk, complexed by hints of lanolin and toast. The flavoursome palate boasts unctuous red berry fruits, complemented by brioche characters, and is fine but with firm, savoury tannins. It has persistent flavours finishing with crisp natural acid.

**Lanson Brut Rose, Ponte di Piave, Italy.....156**

Salmon colour, fresh and vibrant aromas with raspberry, citrus fruit aromas with toasty undertones. The palate is lively with intensely flavoured lemon peel and sweet spice.

# Whites

## RIESLING

**2018 Teusner Empress Riesling, Eden Valley, SA** .....11/40

Pure citrus flavours, orange blossom, white flowers and talc

**2017 Woodvale Watervale Reisling, Clare Valley, SA** .....45

Kevin Mitchell - Clare Valley Winemaker of the year. Created in a bone dry style, a classic watervale riesling with all the expression the region is so famous for; intense limes, citrus notes, zesty natural acidity, good length. Mouthwatering.

**2008 Wilson DJW Museum Riesling, Clare Valley, SA** .....56

This wine shows all the hallmarks of aged Clare Valley Riesling, with citrus, honey, grapefruit and a whiff of kerosene, all with that classic slaty minerality the Rieslings of this iconic region are revered for.

## FIANO

**2018 Phaedrus Fiano, Mornington Peninsula, VIC** .....44

Spice and floral aromas flow through on the palate, with a crisp clean finish - typical of this Italian wine variety. A perfect aperitivo with antipasto

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

**2018 Checkerboard Sauvignon Blanc, Mt Benson, SA** .....7.5/28

Citrus, passionfruit and tropical fruits. Palate fresh and crisp with a long dry finish

**2018 Baby Doll Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ** .....9.5/36

Passionfruit and blackcurrant. Fresh full palate with a zesty mineral finish

**2016 Claude Riffault Sancerre, Languedoc, France** .....146

Complex fresh fruit of pear and melon on the nose along with some subtle herbal/grassy notes on the palate. Tart and crisp cold, but as it warms in the glass it gives you just a hint of cream on the finish.

## SEMILLON

**2017 Flametree Sauvignon Blanc Semillon, Margaret River, WA** .....10/38

Fresh lively blend of citrus and stone fruits. Long crisp palate.

**2012 Peter Lehmann Margaret Semillon, Barossa Valley SA** .....58

The bouquet shows hints of lemon flower together with some waxy, honeyed development so typical of great, aged Semillon. The grapes were picked early in the season to retain more natural acidity and the palate is dry with a zesty finish.

## PINOT GRIGIO

### **2017 Velante Pinot Grigio, Italy.....46**

Golden apple, ripe pear and peach. Medium bodies and crisp. The ultimate legitimate Italian grigio.

## PINOT GRIS

### **2018 Yealands Land Made Pinot Gris, Marlborough, NZ.....10/38**

Pear and spice notes. The palate is flavoursome and fresh blanced by a long crisp finish.

### **2017 Phaedrus Pinot Gris, Mornington Peninsula, VIC.....40**

This Pinot Gris is made in the more generous French style - later picking results in riper pear and floral aromas and flavours. These flavours persist through to the palate which is richly textured due to wild yeast fermentation but balanced by fresh acidity. Perfect with rich seafood or Asian flavoured dishes.

## VERDELHO

### **2018 Margan Verdelho, Hunter Valley, NSW .....10/38**

Pineapple, lychee, hints of spice.

## CERBERUS

### **2018 Rochford King Valley Cerberus, VIC.....48**

Here's something diferent. 48% Gewurztraminer, 21% Pinot Blanc, 17% Riesling, 14% Pinot Gris. Long and complex, marginally sweet but savoury, with deep musky floral aromas of lychees and pear. Nutty, creamy, baklava like spices, off dry and viscous palate, finishing with a tight focus and artful balance

## CHARDONNAY

### **2018 Mt Lawson Chardonnay, Mudgee, NSW.....10/36**

Aromas of lemon and stone fruit, the generous mid-palate has mouth-filling textural layers with hints of toast and vibrancy to the fruit. The gentle acid balance opens the palate finishing with soft lingering flavours.

### **2018 Ingram Rd, Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, VIC .....42**

Hand-picked and 100% barrel fermented, it is rich and full fruited without forgetting its Yarra Valley heritage of length; stone fruits are the drivers and the citrus providing the acidity.

### **2014 Bunnamagoo 1827 Chardonnay, Mudgee NSW.....58**

This wine displays its cool climate origins with an array of grapefruit and white peach flavours and a fine citrus acidity overlaid with subtle sweet spiced aromatics derived from Hungarian oak.

### **2016 Scarborough Obsessive Chardonnay, Hunter Valley NSW.....71**

Pale green apple in colour, on the nose enjoy stone fruit aromas with hints of nutmeg and cloves. This Chardonnay is rich and complex yet lean and structured. Catch signs of lemon and lime, cashews and almonds and spice on the palate.

## ROSÉ

**2018 Excuse My French Grenache Rosé**, Languedoc, France.....9.5/36

Pale pink in colour, a very well balanced wine. Fresh, fruity and round.

**2018 Galli Camelback Nebbiolo Rosé**, Clare Valley, SA.....11/39

A unique copper/onionskin colour, displaying wild herbs and bay leaves. Slightly sweet to off dry, with lovely length and body.

## MOSCATO

**2018 Mad Fish Moscato**, Margaret River, WA.....9.5/36

Sweet light style displaying citrus, floral and spice aromas

**NV La Gita Moscato**, McLaren Vale, SA.....38

Aroma of honeydew melon, ripe pear, mandarin and orange all enriched in vibrant elderflower.

The off-dry palate is light and fresh with a gentle spritz from the bubbles. White moscato.

## SPARKLING ROSÉ

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## PINOT NOIR

**2017 Petal and Stem Pinot Noir, Marlborough, NZ .....10.5/38**

A wild bouquet of lifted red cherry, cassis, mocha and spice foreground - a wine that's supple and juicy, with fine tannins and a slightly toasty finish.

**2016 Helens Hill Long Walk Pinot Noir, Yarra Valley, VIC.....50**

Lifted red fruits bouquet, beautiful array of mulberries, dark cherries and ripe pomegranate, a dash of spiciness with white peppers, toast, dried herbs and alba chocolate and tobacco.

The palate is intense and savoury, rich and voluptuous with a firm tannin structure and clean finish.

**2013 Chard Farm "Tiger" Pinot Noir, Central Otago, NZ.....128**

Exudes perfume of crushed red berries and deep fine spice. This red wine provides a silky mouthfeel and shows a broad tannin structure, leading to a long and powerful finish.

A wine of elegance.

## TEMPRANILLO

**2017 Radio Boka Tempranillo, Valencia, Spain.....7.5/30**

Juicy ripe strawberry, succulent dark cherries and an exciting hint of cassis Excellent with pizza

**2016 Lock and Key Reserve Tempranillo, Hilltops, NSW.....48**

A bold, deliciously juicy, joven-style Temperanillo. Bright, lifted notes of maraschino cherry, succulent little sweet blackberries and raspberries with hints of spice. The palate is bright and rich with generous black cherries laced with layers of spice. Well balanced in an elegant restrained style.

## CHIANTI

**2017 Castello di Querceto Chianti DOCG, Italy.....58**

Crunchy, rustic and dry. Light medium bodied with aromas of cherries, sour cherries and violet.

Food matching heaven.

## NEBBIOLO

**2016 Bricco Maiolica Langhe Nebbiolo, Italy.....60**

Soft and elegant with notes of strawberries, currants and roses.

Smooth flavours, fresh and delicate with mild tannins

## NERO D'AVOLA

### **2016 Fondo Antico Nero D'Avola, Italy .....48**

The most common grape varietal in Sicily, Italy. Fresh and fruity, where it is possible to find cherry raspberries and other soft fruit, all backed by a hint of spices.

### **2017 Three Ponds "Holman" Nero D'Avola, Hunter Valley, NSW ..... 53**

Earthy, with supple tannins. Medium-bright ruby in the glass. Nose of red cherries, red plums and cloves. A lovely light palate with slightly darker berries and hints of orange peel and sweet spice. Matches any meat.

## RED BLENDS

### **2014 Geoff Merrill Cabernet Merlot, McLaren Vale, SA.....9.5/36**

Clean varietal characters with ripe berry flavours, subtle tannins and well balanced acidity

### **2017 Tellurian GSM, Heathcote, VIC ..... 55**

A classic blend of Grenache Shiraz and Mourvedre, from the western slopes of the Mt Camel Range. Matured for 10 months in seasoned French oak barriques, the subtle oak complements the elegance of Grenache, intensity of Shiraz and savoury length of Mourvedre

### **2017 Mosswood Amy's Blend, Margaret River, WA.....60**

Lifted dark fruit aromas of mulberries and blackcurrants, backed by some spicy, white pepper notes from the Malbec and musk-like perfumes from the Petit Verdot; complex cedar and tarry notes in the background. The palate was dominated by dark fruit notes, with juicy blackberry and red currant flavours; the acidity and tannin are present but not in any way aggressive and are well balanced

### **2009 Salet Premium Blend Shiraz/ Cabernet Sauvignon, SA .....185**

Handpicked SA fruit. Bouquet displays ripe rich cab sav integrated with toasty French oak. The palate is composed of mellow, sweet succulent fruit.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### **2017 Paxton MV Organic Cabernet Sauvignon, McLaren Vale, SA.....11/40**

Lifted fragrance of paprika and fresh tomato leaves. Full bodied with bright fruit, chocolate, mint, integrated oak and supple tannins

### **2016 Howard Park Miamup Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, WA.....42**

Deep garnet in colour with youthful and classic cabernet aromas of mint, violets, savoury dry herbs and briary hedgerow fruits, all spiced with a touch of mocha and toasted oak.

### **2016 Katnook Amara Cabernet Sauvignon, Coonawarra, SA.....82**

The nose has dark berry fruits, dark cherry with hints of chocolaty oak notes. The pallet is layered dark berry fruit and hints of mulberry. Subtle vanillin oak and lingering, fine grained tannins. An impressive wine from Coonawarra

**2015 Bunnamagoo 1827 Cabernet Sauvignon, Mudgee NSW.....90**

This wine has a supple structure with fine tannins and an array of fragrant cassis, red cherry notes and spices. Oak derived characters of vanilla and fine toast provide a generous finish.

**2013 Howard Park “Abercrombie” Cab Sav, Margaret River, WA.....145**

Very rich and concentrated with soft tannins, moderate acidity. Full bodied offering lots of ripe fruits of blackberries, cherries and blackcurrant along with eucalyptus, oak and spices. A very long finish

**2009 Salet Cabernet Sauvignon, SA .....210**

This wine displays blackberry cassis with a hint of spice and liquorice and has been matured in American oak for three years in an air conditioned environment allowing the tannins to soften.

## SHIRAZ

**2016 Maxwell Silver Hammer Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA.....10.5/38**

Deep purple colour with blackberry, plum and chocolate aroma. Rich mouth feel, blood plum, vanilla and fine tannins.

**2016 Paxton Jones Block Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA.....68**

Intense fruit with blueberry and fruit cake characters and skillfully layered oak. The palate is full bodied and full of flavour, with black olive tapenade and smoked short rib characters. A subtle yet sleek wine that packs a flavour punch.

**2010 Salet Red Healer Shiraz, SA .....180**

Deep rich intense purple colour with a bouquet of full rich ripe blackberry and blackcurrant fruit. The palate provides a mouth filling balance of intense rich ripe fruit flavours integrated with tasty oak and leaves a firm finish giving a pleasant easy drinking quality wine. 16% alcohol - this wine is a big one!

**2007 Salet Shiraz, SA .....250**

This outstanding wine has a deep brick red colour with intense berry/plum and oak characters from it's maturation in French oak for 60 months in the cellars climate controlled environment. The nose displays intense berry plum oak characters and the palate gives intense rich plum and spice integrated with oak.

## MALBEC

**2016 Vinaceous Voodoo Moon Malbec, Margaret River, WA.....11/40**

Earth and spicy vanilla on nose with touches of white pepper. Nice dark red purple colour with a medium mouth feel. Taste of red cherry and leather with firm almost grippy tannins

**2016 Pulenta La Flor Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina.....52**

Royal purple with aromas of cherry, strawberry and delicate lavender and violet notes, with hints of vanilla in the background. Vibrant and round, with pliable, ripe tannins and lively acidity.
